This position is accountable and responsible for providing direction, team leadership, planning, implementation and evaluation of inpatient and outreach services consistent with the vision, mission and business plan of Alberta Health Services. The position is accountable and responsible for making day-to-day operational decisions and having direct responsibility for contributing to the achievement of the goals of the assigned services/programs. One of the key duties for the next 12 months will be to establish the day-to-day operations for a 10-bed unit inpatient psychiatry unit to provide services for formal patients under the Mental Health Act of Alberta. This will include hiring new staff, staff training and developing and revising policies and procedures. The Unit Manager will establish a client-centered care process to meet accreditation standards. Services provided will be concurrent capable with a primary focus in the treatment of mental health disorders and recognize that patients may have intermittent substance use and/or misuse, or a long standing chronic addiction disorder.
